Background in 1 Cor. 15:1-8 for the Early Church of wavering faith.

I. Remain Thankful

- V. 57a keep a good attitude
- 1 Chron. 16:34
- Eph. 5:19-20
- Ps. 100:4
- Phil. 4:6-7

A good attitude in the midst of the battle is vital! **Do you keep a thankful attitude?**

II. Remember the Victory

- V. 57b
- Rom. 8:37
- 2 Cor. 2:14
- Ps. 20:7-8

Also our focus on victory through Jesus Christ is vital in the midst of the battle! **Do you remain focused on the victory through Jesus Christ?**

III. Remain United!

- V. 58 the Devil's #1 tactic is to divide and conquer
- 2 Chron. 20:1-4, 13

- Acts 2

Not only are our attitude and focus in victory important but also that we remain united– in families, churches, countries.

Do you seek unity in the midst of the battle?

IV. Remain Steadfast and Immovable

- V. 58b
 - Grk. steadfast= settled
 - Immovable= NOT moving
- Heb. 10:23
- Heb. 3:14
- 1 Cor. 16:13
- James 1:12

People have a tendency to want to quit the battle. Flexibility is great, but we must remain committed.

Do you waver in your beliefs in the midst of the battle?

V. Remain His Servant

- V. 58c&d
 - Grk. abounding= superior, excellence
- Gal. 2:20
- 2 Cor. 4:5
- Rom. 10:9
