- Rom. 8:28

Today—

“In the midst of your storm”

Our text— **Mark 6:45-52**

I. He made the disciples

- V. 45 made= ἀναγκάζω (anagkazó)= compelled, constrained
- He is not surprised. We all face storms.
- The intent was to get to the other side; the storm was part of the JOURNEY.

Are you willing to go to the other side, no matter the journey?

II. He was praying!

- V. 46 He departed
- Rom. 8:34, Heb. 7:25

Do you sincerely believe Jesus is praying for you?

III. He saw them!

- V. 48 He saw them straining with the wind against them
- John says they were 3-4 miles out and in the dark
- Ps. 33:18
- Ps. 34:15
- I Pet. 3:12
- It was third watch. The time Jacob wrestled with an angel, Peter was in chains, Samuel heard his name. This time is significant!
- He SEES! In our sin, hurt and pain!

Do you sincerely believe He sees you?

IV. He came to them

- V. 48
- He came into the storm.
- Matt. 28:20
- Is. 41:10
- Heb. 13:5
- Jn. 15

Do you sincerely believe He is with you... always?

V. They didn't recognize Him!

- V. 49 a ghost
- In fear, not seeing Him!
- 1 Cor. 13:11-12

Are there times you don't recognize Him or what He is doing?

VI. He went into the boat!

- V. 51
- Jn. 6:21 The disciples... willingly= θέλω (theló)=pleased them
- The storm stopped and they arrived!

Have you discovered in life's journey, His ability to quiet the storms and get you to your destination?
